

**Chisago Lakes High School reached the 5% student absence mark for influenza -like illness on Monday, October 5<sup>th</sup>. The MN Dept of Health was notified per 2009-10 influenza season protocol.**

*Symptoms of influenza-like illness (ILI) include fever, cough, sore throat, muscle aches, or fatigue and sometimes vomiting and diarrhea. If your child has a health condition (such as asthma, diabetes, lung or heart problems or is pregnant) you should contact their health care provider for instructions, especially if your child develops influenza symptoms.*

*Chisago Lakes Area Schools is currently teaming with the Chisago County Public Health Department to plan and schedule H1N1 vaccination clinics for November, 2009 (to be held at our school sites). Consents for vaccination and complete details will be sent home with all students when it becomes available to us.*
