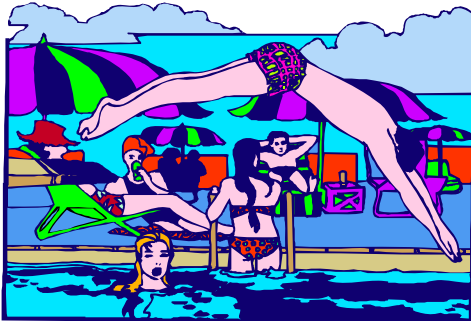

What facilities are available?

We have a 25 meter wide by 25 yard long eight lane main pool. The water depth ranges from 3'6" to 12'. The air temperature ranges from 85° - 86° and water temperature ranges from 85° - 86° .



An attached diving well of 12' depth with a one meter springboard.

We have a separate 10' by 20' wading pool designed for infants and preschoolers. Depth range is 1' to 1'6", and the water temperature is 88° - 89°



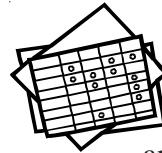
A separate Hot Tub with a capacity of eight people. Great for therapeutic use or just to relax. The Hot Tub water temperature ranges from 101° - 103°.

What do I get for my money?

Full private use of our facility. The rental fee includes lifeguards and custodial cleanup. The party package details the amenities.



When can I rent the swim pool?



Generally we will rent out our high school swimming pool anytime it is not already programmed for school or community use. Most often that is weekends, but we do have some weeknights available if our swim team is at an away event or we are between swimming lessons sessions.



How do I make a reservation?

Complete a **High School Swim Pool Use Permit form**. You may pick up a permit form at the school district office, go to the web site, or simply leave your name and address on our voicemail 651.213.2604 and a permit form will be mailed to you.



You also need to include a \$15 non refundable deposit with your request.

Once the form is received in our offices, we will determine the availability of the facility at the requested date(s) and time(s). If the pool is available a confirmation permit will be prepared and returned to you. You need then to take that confirmation with you when using the facility and pay the remaining fee when you swim.

Water, Water, Water, everywhere: *A Pool of Options*

Flat rentals: Includes private use of the facility and also includes the necessary certified staff. The fee is prorated to your time of use. You are welcome to bring any water toys you desire and you may bring any commercially prepared foods you wish. (Homemade items are not allowed in our facility.)

Party package: We offer a basic package which includes food, pool time and the necessary certified staff. Other amenities can also be added to customize your package. If you have a very busy schedule just leave the details to us! This package is limited to District #2144 residents only.
